Our history

AUMA was created in response to the challenges of urban mobility in Africa. During the Sustainable Mobility Week in October 2022 in Dakar, authorities decided to formalize an exchange framework to promote collaboration. Supported by the African Transport Policy Program (SSATP), the association was created on February 21, 2023 in Abidjan with the adoption of its statutes. AUMA aims to strengthen the capacities of AOMUs and promote sustainable mobility solutions across the continent.

AUMA positions itself as the main communication platform for urban transport authorities in Africa. By bringing together Urban Mobility Authorities (UMA's), decision-makers, experts and citizens, we aim to promote sustainable and inclusive mobility solutions adapted to African realities.
